Autism Anglia, a

registered charity which promotes education, care and support to people with autism and their families. It has been produced in conjunction with Bedfordshire Police and Hertfordshire and Cambridgeshire Constabularies.

The credit sized card can be carried at all times and can be displayed if a person (or their carer) finds themselves in a situation where it may be difficult to give an explanation about the condition. It will also assist the police and emergency services to identify that they are dealing with someone who has autism. The card gives some simple advice, the cardholder's name and space for two emergency contact details.
